See the person and not the deafness first, and do all the normal things - deafness doesn't stop you playing and having fun together.

Hearing/non-disabled siblings may be expected to take care of or watch over deaf/disabled siblings and, depending on family dynamics, can feel enhanced empathy or overprotectiveness, along with feelings of over-burden, resentment, jealousy, or guilt (Aronson, 2009; Berkowitz & Jonas, 2014; Wennick & Huus, 2012). According to our findings, when these siblings are DHH themselves, they can identify with the DHH sibling based on their own experiences, while also feeling saved from the attitude ...

Seventeen children were deaf (M = 98.76 dB HL, SD = 3.68), 5 had severe hearing losses (M = 72.20 dB HL, SD = 1.64), and 8 had moderate hearing losses (M = 47.25 dB HL, SD = 6.13). All children communicated orally with their siblings and parents.

One of the major events for parents of deaf children is that of diagnosis of the child's deafness. This is a significant event as the vast majority of deaf children are born to hearing parents who do not expect their child to be deaf. However, the circumstances of diagnosis have changed. In the 1960s, diagnosis before two years of age was rare.
